SUB: Grant of ad-hoc ex-gratia allowance to Burma Civilian Pensioners/  
family pensioners and widows who are Indian Nationals and receiv-  
ing payment from the Government of Burma.


The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.5/14/91-PA&PW(B) dated the 9th March, 1992 (copy enclosed) on above mentioned subject and to say that the ad-hoc ex-gratia allowance admissible to persons in receipt of Civil Pension from the Government of India has been reviewed in the light of representations received from a large number of pensioners.

2. It has now been decided on compassionate grounds to increase the ex-gratia allowance in respect of those Burma Pensioners who are also in receipt of civil pension from the Government of India. The ex-gratia allowance, in each case will be so fixed as to increase the existing pension/family pension and any relief sanctioned by the Govt. of Burma to Rs.375/- p.m.

3. These orders will take effect from the date of issue and the excess payment of ad-hoc ex-gratia allowance already made, if any, may be adjusted from the enhanced amount of ex-gratia allowance.

4. This Office Memorandum issues with the concurrence of Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure vide their U.O.No.776/EV/93 dated 13-3-1993 and U.O.No.925/EV/93 dated 1-10-1993.

5. In so far as persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned these orders have been issued in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
